



Quilt Challenge 2011

We are excited to announce our first quilt challenge for the Stitches in Bloom Quilt Show, January 28 & 29, 2011!

We chose our challenge fabric from Jody Houghton's Earth Blessings' collection. Jody has been a vendor at Stitches in Bloom since the first year and it's an honor choose a local designer.

The challenge fabric is Earth Blessings Patchwork, 6767-30. And suggested coordinates are: 6755-24, 6755-37, 6755-53, 6755-43, 6755-30, 6755-71, 6755-74, 6755-99, 6756-24, 6756-43, 6756-30, 6756-71, and 6756-99.

Challenge Rules:

- 1) At least one fat quarter of the challenge fabric, Earth Blessings Patchwork, # 6767-30, must be used as an integral part of the quilt and must appear in the body of the quilt
- 2) Any amount of any other fabric may be used. Suggested coordinates are listed above, but you may choose any fabrics you like.
- 3) Quilts may be any shape, but no larger than 36"x36'
- 4) Each quilt must have a finished sleeve of 4" attached to the top back for hanging
- 5) A fabric identification label must be securely sewn to a bottom back corner with the same full name and address as it appears on the entry form as well as the title of the entry.
- 6) Panels, pre-printed pieces and unfinished quilts will not be accepted
- 7) By definition, a quilt is two layers of fabric with a filling that is stitched together with lines or a pattern. Quilting must be done by hand or machine. Tied quilts do not meet the definition of a quilt for this challenge.

Quilts must be submitted with an entry form and \$10 fee by January 7th, 2011 to:
